### [Do you need to use UKCA marking?](#)

For over a year, Romark has been fulfilling UKCA labelling requirements and helping our clients meet the new standards of post-Brexit operations. As of the 24th of August 2021, the deadline for applying the UKCA mark was extended to January 2023, which we are now fast approaching.



"Recognising the impact of the pandemic on businesses, the government will extend this deadline to 1 January 2023 to apply UKCA marks for certain products to demonstrate compliance with product safety regulations, rather than 1st January 2022." - **gov.uk**
