## HGV Licence Categories and its wages Per Hour

C1 Driver Licence

- You are permitted to drive vehicles weighing between 3,500 and 7,500 kg MAM with a trailer up to 750kg.
- The general Payscale for a C1 driver is approximately £13 – £13.50 per hour, additionally depending on the location.

### C1+E Driver Licence

- With a trailer weighing more than 750kg, you can drive a C1 category vehicle. Both of their MAMs should not be over 12,000kg.
- The pay scale for a C1+E driver is approximately £13 – £16 per hour depending on location and the organisation you are working for.

### Category C Driver

- Vehicles weighing more than 3,500kg are allowed to be driven with a trailer up to 750kg MAM.
- The Pay scale for Category C is approx £16 – £20 per hour as per the location preference.

### Category C+E Driver

- With a trailer weighing more than 750kg, you can drive a category C vehicle.
- Income for the C+E category is approx £18 – £22 per hour as per the location.
